

How to get to the Campus Village...

If driving...

From Edinburgh and the North of England, take Exit 15 off the M8 motorway. At the second set of traffic lights turn left, then first right. The Campus Village is on the right.

if arriving by rail...

Arrivals from the west and most intercity services arrive at Central Station from where a few minutes taxi drive or a fifteen minute walk will take you to the Campus Village. Arrivals from Edinburgh and the east come into Queen Street, just a 10 minute walk from the Campus Village.

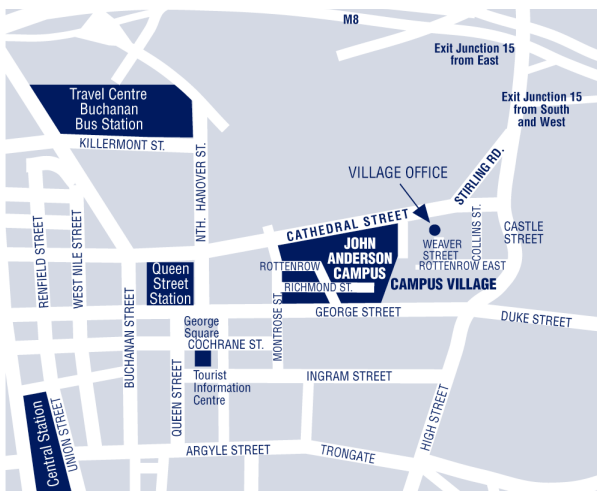
if arriving by air...

FROM GLASGOW AIRPORT, a frequent bus service will take guests to Buchanan Bus Station, a 15 minute walk from the Campus Village.

The BUS from Glasgow Airport to Buchanan Street Bus Station takes 25 minutes. Buses run from 6am to 6pm every 20 minutes, then every 30 minutes until midnight. The Bus Station is a 15 minute walk from the Campus Village. Phone Traveline Scotland on 0870 608 2608 for further information.

The TAXI FARE from Glasgow Airport to the Campus Village is approximately £17.00.

FROM PRESTWICK AIRPORT, a frequent train service runs to Central Station, a few minutes by taxi or a 15 minute walk from the Campus Village.

Information for guests at the Campus Village

The Village Office

The Village Office is the Visitor Reception for the Campus Village and is situated under the Lord Todd Restaurant. The office is open daily from 8am until 6pm. There is a night porter based in the Office outwith these hours. Rooms are usually available from 1pm. Please telephone to make appropriate arrangements if you expect to arrive early in the morning or late in the evening.

Catering

All meals included in your booking are served in the Lord Todd Restaurant, above the Village Office. Self-service breakfast is available from 7.30am until 9am, unless otherwise advised by your conference/group organiser.

Bar

Todd's bar is open daily but please note that it does not hold a licence for children. It is usually open from 11am to 11pm Monday to Friday, 11am to 12.30pm and 5pm to 11pm on Saturdays and 12.30pm to 2.30pm and 6.30pm to 11pm on Sundays.

Televisions

Television lounges are situated on Levels 2 & 4 in Murray Hall and in the lounges of Flats of James Young, Chancellors, James Gould, Forbes and Garnett Halls.

Telephones

Each guest bedroom is equipped with a telephone that can be used for out-going calls only. Cards to the value of £3.00 and £5.00 may be purchased from the NTL machine, which is situated in the Village Office.

Laundry

There is a coin-operated laundry near the Village Office which takes £1 and 20p coins only. The laundry is equipped with an iron and ironing board.

Service of Rooms

Bed and Breakfast guest rooms are cleaned and beds made daily except on weekends and public holidays. Self-Catering flats are serviced and linen changed weekly.

Sports Facilities

Information about the University's sports facilities is displayed in the Village Office.

Tea and Coffee Making Facilities

These are available in all rooms. The kettle may be found in the kitchen area of each flat. Additional supplies are available from the Village Office.

Mail/Telephone Messages

All mail is received at the Village Office and is held there for collection by guests.

Parking

Unfortunately there is no general car parking on the campus. There are, however, public car parks located close by.

Luggage/Porters

There are no porters available at the Village Office.

Bank and Post Office

The nearest ATM is located facing the Village Office on Cathedral Street. Most cards will be accepted. The nearest Post Office is situated on High Street and is open Monday to Friday 9am - 5pm.

Departure

On the day of departure, rooms should be vacated by 10am and keys returned to the Village Office. Late departure may result in additional charges.

Payment of Accounts

All guests should settle their account prior to or upon arrival at the Village Office, unless they are part of a Conference or Group who have made alternative arrangements.
